2024 Title IX Regulations

Think you understand Title IX, the federal law that prohibits discrimination based on sex in the College's education program and activities? Have you heard that new Title IX regulations may go into effect in 2024? Do you have questions about your obligations under Title IX?

Participants will explore those questions and receive an overview of the following key topics

related to Title IX at Montgomery College:

With pending rule changes that could go into effect in 2024, participants will learn about the expanded scope of sex-based discrimination under Title IX, including sex characteristics, sex

stereotypes and gender expression, and the new definition of sex-based harassment.

Participants will review the resolution process the College currently uses to investigate and resolve allegations of sex-based harassment and receive an introduction to the new model that

may go into effect soon.

The role of employees as mandatory reporters will be explained so they are empowered to fulfill institutional obligations when made aware of conduct that could constitute discrimination

based on sex.

The rights of students experiencing pregnancy and related conditions will be explained so that participants understand their obligations to support the academic success of these students.

Linguistic Bias in Higher Education

Although language experts widely agree that all languages are equal, language discrimination is still sometimes viewed as "the last acceptable prejudice" (R.L.G., 2015). Hidden biases can create barriers for multilingual speakers, English language learners, speakers of non-standard dialects, and anyone who communicates in ways that are considered outside the norm. In this workshop, we will explore ways that linguistic bias can appear in higher education classrooms, how bias can limit academic participation, and practical strategies instructors can use to make their teaching more inclusive for all.
