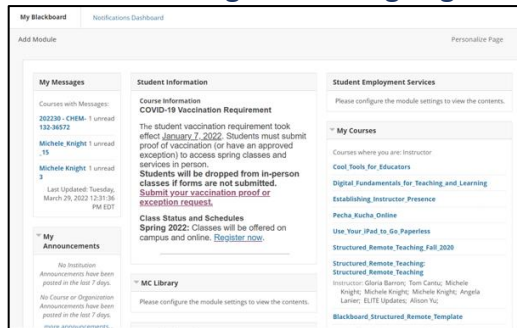


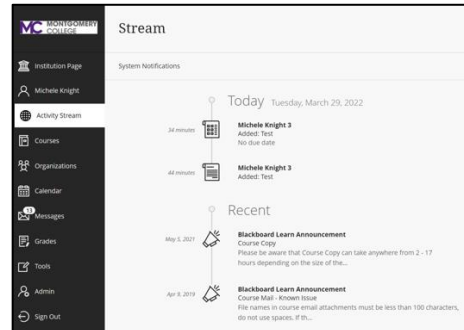
Blackboard's 5/19/2022 upgrade to Base Navigation
