students

participated in the online survey



85.3%

of respondents

believe MC would take a reported incident of sexual misconduct seriously

"I feel safe on campus."

82%

of respondents

strongly agree or agree with this statement



Sexual Harassment was reported as the most experienced form of Sexual Misconduct (56.7%), followed by Stalking, Non-Consensual Sexual Contact, Sexual Exploitation, Domestic Violence, Non-Consensual Sexual Intercourse, Dating Violence, and Sexual Intimidation.



88.8%

of respondents

have not experienced unwanted sexual violence or unwanted sexual contact since coming to MC

"I know where to report sexual misconduct."



59.6%

of respondents

strongly agree or agree with this statement

The survey's results indicate that MC has a culture of respect where students feel empowered to speak up against sexual violence, to intervene in inappropriate situations, and to create an environment where survivors are supported.
