IERW = **I**ntegrated **E**nglish **R**eadings and **W**riting

Instead of taking ENGL 001 and READ 095, take

IERW 001: For native speakers of English and designed to improve reading and writing skills, IERW 001 combines the intermediate college reading skills and writing skills required for success in credit-level courses. Writing activities start at the sentence and paragraph level, writing correct sentences, well-developed paragraphs, and multi-paragraph essays. Upon successful completion, students advance to IERW 002 or ENGL 101A according to discipline guidelines. PREREQUISITE: Accuplacer Reading score between 53 and 65. **ENGL 001+READ 095=10 hours; IERW 001=6 hours!**

Instead of taking ENGL 002 and READ 099, take

IERW 002: For native speakers of English and designed to improve reading and writing skills, IERW 002 combines the advanced college reading skills and essay-level writing skills required for success in credit-level courses. Writing activities emphasize multi-paragraph essays. Upon successful completion, students advance to ENGL 101/A according to discipline guidelines. PREREQUISITE: Completion of IERW 001 with a C grade or Accuplacer Reading score between 66 and 78. **ENGL 002+READ 099=8 hours; IERW 002=5 hours!**
