Type of Assessment	CAT Feedback
Program Assessment	There appears to be a misalignment with the measure and outcome for the outcome that states “a student will be able to explain the historic . . .” Generally, an outcome with the word “explain” requires an essay and not a multiple-choice test to assess student learning. <i>The Collegewide Assessment Team requests that you consider this concern and provide a response by March 1, 2016.</i> Please update the assessment plan and resubmit if changes are made.
Program Assessment	Learning outcomes clear and measurable. Good connection to general education competencies.
General Education	This reflection is a good example of explaining the context of the results as well as the strengths and weaknesses.
General Education	Would like the department to consider assessments that would yield a wider spectrum of results so that there can be better information in next cycle – if almost everyone is successful, it might be more useful to assess with more rigor.
